

Curricular Committee
Annual Report for Academic Session 2020-21

Objective of the Committee:

Curricular committee works under the IQAC and is responsible to monitor the effective delivery of the curriculum to help the college achieve the program objectives and observe program outcomes as per the mission statement of the college.

It also monitors the Teaching-Learning process, provides requisite support for the process by preparing schedule for the same and various other formats for effective curriculum delivery. It also ensures the support of required campus facilities such as availability of classrooms, ICT support, laboratories, etc. The committee is also responsible for collecting and analysing the feedback from the stakeholders regarding Teaching / Learning Process, Campus Facilities and the Curriculum.

Working Mechanism:

To achieve its very objectives, the curricular committee

- Ensures that the teacher has prepared his / her Monthly Teaching Plan for the academic year
- Ensures that the teachers' follow the proposed Monthly Teaching Plan through the Monthly Teaching Execution statement
- Ask for the comments from the Heads of the departments regarding the execution of the Monthly Teaching Plan
- Collect, analyse and report the feedback of teachers from students regarding Teaching / Learning Process
- Collect, analyse and report the feedback of College from parents regarding Teaching / Learning Process and Campus Facilities
- Collect, analyse and report the feedback of College from alumni regarding Teaching / Learning Process and Campus Facilities and the Curriculum.
- Collect, analyse and report the feedback of Curriculum from teachers.

Monitoring Process:

- The committee meets two times in a semester to monitor the specified working mechanism and prepares / updates required formats, ensures all teachers / departments follow the guidelines and schedule prescribed by the committee. The formats include ...
 - The Monthly Teaching Plan
 - The Monthly Teaching Execution Statement
 - The statement of comments from the Heads of the departments
 - Questionnaires for feedback
- The committee collects the Monthly Teaching Plan from every teacher at the beginning of the academic session.
- The Monthly Teaching Execution Statement and The statement of comments from the Heads of the departments are kept at the respective departments itself. The Principal, IQAC representative and a committee member visit the departments once in a semester to ensure that the teachers / departments are following the guidelines and schedule prescribed by the committee.
- Feedback is collected and analysed at the end of every year.

- The curriculum delivery status and observed feedback performance is reported to the IQAC. The Heads of the departments also report the curriculum delivery status to the IQAC. The Principal after discussion with the IQAC reports it to the College Development Council (CDC).
- After due approvals from the CDC, Principal and IQAC, the remarks are communicated to the relevant stakeholders along with the suggestions / recommendations (if any), for remedial actions.

Observations:

The spread of pandemic Covid-19 has drastically disrupted every aspects of human life including education. It has created an unprecedented test on education. On the backdrop of Corona Pandemic situation, the college was closed from 16th March,2020 till the regular session end. This situation resulted into following irregularities...

- Teaching Learning process badly hampered.
- The curriculum delivery was accomplished online. Most of the teachers tried their best to cover the maximum portion, but also faced the problems of connectivity and lower attendance percentage.
- Feedback for odd semesters could not be processed.
- Internal Tests / Assignments / Term end examination / other term work could not be completed. However the assessments were conducted through MCQ based online tests by most of the teachers.
