Since to conduct Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA) for the departments is not direct responsibility if the Curricular Committee, it was decided to communicate it to the IQAC so that IQAC can make the relevant arrangements for conduct of AAA.
- 6. About the details regarding Add on /Certificate programs offered during the year Dr. Bajpeyee pointed out the importance of the Add on /Certificate programs offered during the year, it was also discussed that these courses are important in terms of the students and the criteria of SSR 1.2.2 and 1.2.3. accordingly WhatsApp notices will be issued for its quickening. Dr. Bajpeyee pointed that issuing such notices is a regular practice of the Committee.
- 7. To establish mechanism for assessing the learning levels of the students and organize special programmes for it

3. To establish mechanism for effective curriculum delivery through a well-planned and documented process (1.1.1)

Well planned and documented work is more important. Its mechanism for effective curriculum delivery through a well-planned and documented process will be initiated and accordingly notices will be continuously circulated through WhatsApp groups. It was also pointed that the same parameters will be utilized in the criterion 1.1.1 of the SSR. Its responsibility is given to Dr. A. P. Vaidya. College time table and its implementation is an important issue. Through the HoDs and in-charge it will be ensured. HoDs will communicate the details to the Principal for further action.

- 4. To promote and track the participation of teachers in the activities related to curriculum development and assessment
  - It was discussed about the requirements of the College Curricular Committee / SSR / NAAC and as per the criterion 1.1.3 of SSR. It is required to promote and track the participation of teachers in the activities related to curriculum development and assessment of the affiliating University and their representation on the academic bodies during the year. The responsibility is given to Dr. A. P. Vaidya to note and to submit to the Committee.
- 5. To suggest to establish student centric methods for enhancing learning experiences

It was discussed to suggest the mechanism of student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem-solving methodologies to be used for enhancing learning experiences. Dr. Bajpeyee focused that it is reflected in the criterion 2.3.1 of SSR. The suggestions are given to the IQAC for refining the student centric methods.

2. To promote the use of ICT enabled tools for effective teaching-learning process (TLE)

It was pointed that the use of ICT in the regular TLE is not up to the mark. Some of the teachers are using it exhaustively but some require to increase the use of ICT. So to promote the use of ICT enabled tools for effective teaching-learning process, suggestions are given to IQAC. Noted that it is also reflected in the criteria=on 2.3.2 of SSR.

3. To Collect feedbacks

The process of feedback collection through online mode is initiated. Dr. Bajpeyee has given responsibility to prepare google form and to circulate it. But he said that physical pen-paper mode and other e-modes be made available for the collection of the feedbacks. The process feedback and to prepare action taken report on the syllabus and its transaction at the institution from the relevant stakeholders is important issue. It is also reflected in the criterion 1.4.1 and 1.4.2 of SSR. So it was decided to collect feedbacks from the students and the teachers by preparing the proforma.

4. To observe and maintain that the Institutional infrastructure

It is a regular practice of the Committee to prepare the time-table as per the balance of the courses and the physical conduct of the classes. Since the infrastructure is not adequate as per the University guidelines, it was already communicated to IWQAC to process further. After having observations, it was communicated to the Principal to initiate for to maintain the Institutional infrastructure, note of adequacy and other relevant physical facilities for teaching-learning which includes classrooms, laboratories, computing equipment etc. It is noted that it is also reflected in the criterion 4.1.1 of SSR.

- 5. To keep track of number of classrooms and seminar halls with ICT and LMS It is very much required to keep track of number of classrooms and seminar halls with ICT facilities including LMS, since the issue is related to the administration, it was communicated to the IQAC. It is noted that the details of the same is required for criterion 4.1.3 of SSR also.

2. Reporting on the basis of the University notification no. 29/2023 published on Dtd. 24-02-2023

Dr. Bajpeyee focused that as per the University notification no. 29/2023 published on Dtd. 24-02-2023, work is in process. He also pointed that some of the major issues as a guidelines are as under:

The time table on Sundays is as under:

- a) It was registered that you all have completed your duties (other than those who were on leaves) as per the time table (2022-23) on the Sundays i.e. 26-02-2023 (conducted working of Monday), 05-03-2023 (conducted working of Tuesday) and 12-03-2023 (conducted working of Wednesday)
- b) Since each teacher has to complete his 90 days schedule for actual teaching (Even Semesters 2022-23) as per the University guidelines, methodologies of filling us the gap is as under:
  - 8 minute in each lecture is added so that one day (Sunday) gap may be filled-in in advanced.
  - So timetable 2022-23 will be in this accordance. It is required to communicate it to all the students and concerned stakeholders.
- c) Maintain five clock hours stay at College strictly. Since it is a crucial and special time for all of us including students, stay for extra hours at the College to complete TLE work.
- d) Time-table in the morning shift (or if the afternoon shifts are changed to the morning shifts) be maintained as per this issuance.
- e) Same schedule as per the time table 2022-23 (with increased 8 minutes in each lecture) will be in force on Friday, 05-05-2023 also. With the serious note that on this day (05-05-2023) there is no holiday.
- f) This will be continued till this academic session ends as per the University calendar and one day extra on 05-05-2023.
- g) Attendance register on these days will be available in the Principal's office, in case of non-attendance through biometric impression due to long span of the College.
- h) Maintain the schedule strictly without excuses and seeking much more leaves.
- i) It is required to submit the details of lectures conducted on the Sundays (26-02-2023, 05-03-2023 & 03-2023) up to 16th March 2023 for which no reminders be given.
- j) Principal has his own notings of lectures, after the data received from concerned, it will be compared to check the worth of these three days.

- k) So, circulate immediately the notice in all the groups of the students, display it on the notice boards and concerned to implement it from first lecture of 15-03-2023 morning.
- 1) Tell all the students to bring separate water bottle and handy food, if needed for more stay.

#### Effective curriculum delivery through a well planned and documented process

The institution has a well-conceived process of curriculum planning and execution under the broad guidelines of SGBA University, Amravati. The college at the beginning of the session constitutes Curricular Committee comprising of 04-05 members representing all the concerned streams. A senior member heads the committee. The committee interacts with the teachers regarding effective ways of curriculum planning and implementation. On the basis of this feedback the committee in its meetings designs different formats to ensure planning of syllabi and its timely and effective execution. The committee ensures the smooth and effective execution of curricular processes through periodic feedbacks from the department-heads. Apart from this on the departmental level the committee ensures that Course Outcomes, Program Specific and Program Outcomes are communicated to the students. The Committee promotes remedial coaching for slow learners to improve their learning outcomes. The committee designs the formats for: a) Teaching-plan b) Teaching -execution c) HoD-Analysis d) Students' Feedback on teaching-learning and evaluation. The committee prepares its annual report based on HoD analysis and the analysis of Students' feedback. The report along with suggestions for improvement if any is submitted to the Principal. The principal discusses the report with IQAC. Letters of suggestions for improvement / commendation for good performance are issued to the concerned faculty members. The faculty members, in response to the letters, ensure the Principal that they would follow suggestive measures to improve the performance.

The institutional hierarchy in this regards is as follows: University Calendar-CDC –Principal-IQAC-Curricular Committee-HoD-Individual Faculty Members.

The whole process is documented on various levels. The individual teachers keep the record of daily teaching along with the monthly teaching plans. For this purpose the committee designs Daily Diary for the teachers. Secondly the formats for teaching execution are filled in regularly by the teachers. The teachers' formats are reviewed by the Curricular committee through respective HoDs. Such reviews ensure effective curriculum delivery through suggestions for corrective measures. Based on the individual teachers' records HoD makes his analysis and submits it to the Committee.

#### **Guidelines for:**

#### **Zero Test, Bridge Course & Remedial Coaching**

#### **Zero Test/Baseline Test**

- 1. This test is for assessing the entry level skills of the students entering the course (BA I/ BCom I / BSc I/MSc I)
- 2. This test designed as per the syllabus/skills of qualifying class (Std. XII) to be given to the students in the first week of the beginning of the academic year.
- 3. Based on the result of the test, the teacher makes a list of the student lacking the skills/knowledge for the admitted Course

#### **Bridge Course**

- 1. Bridge Course is a Crash-Course given to the students NOT qualifying the Zero Test/Baseline Test
- 2. The contents of the Bridge-Course should include the basic Knowledge/Skills for the syllabus of the First Year of the Course
- 3. The duration of the Bridge Course should be accommodated within the actual Teaching Schedule as reflected in the Institutional Academic Calendar.
- 4. The Bridge Course may vary in duration from 1 Week to 3 Weeks

#### **Remedial Coaching**

- 1. Remedial Coaching is to be offered to the students falling behind in the class in terms of academic achievements.
- 2. Such students may be termed as Slow-Learners
- 3. Slow Learners may be determined by analysing the results of the University examination
- 4. List of Slow Learners can also be prepared by using Classroom observations by the teachers
- 5. Slow learners to be given Remedial Coaching by preparing a separate Time Table apart from the Regular Time Table of the college
- 6. The duration of the Remedial Coaching may vary based on the needs of the students
