- 2. In this accordance syllabus of UG and PG were prepared and submitted by concerned Board of Studies to the University.

- 3. University did not take any immediate action and didn't publish the syllabus in due course of time.
- 4. Session started in the month of June 2022 but syllabus was launched without using legal instruments through the website.

- 6. University Academic Calendar for the colleges was disturbed and changed for three times in the session 2022-23, more confused notification regarding academic calendar was recently displayed on 24 February 2023.

Part B] Recommendations

- 1. It is required to publish the syllabus of full course well in advanced before the start of any course of the University
- 2. Under special circumstances (not of worth in a system) it is required to publish the syllabus of at least next two semesters well before the start of next semesters in the academic session 2023-24 (probably in the month of May)
- 3. It is required to maintain the well-planned University academic calendar without having major changes in it.
- 4. Always think about the students, their mental status and duration of sustaining the lectures while preparing University academic calendar especially for the Colleges
