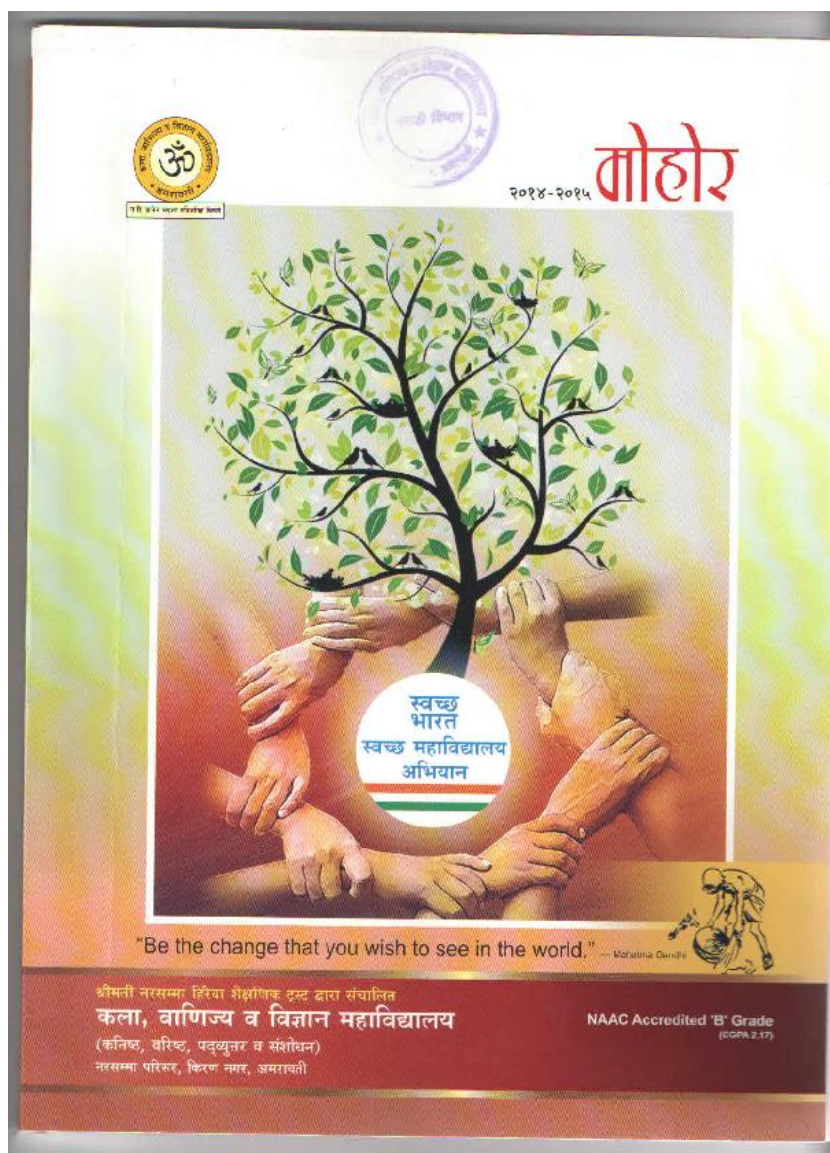

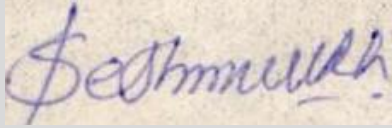


IQAC work, initiatives, strategies and the innovations introduced:

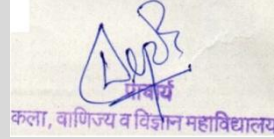
