#### **Background:**

This is the continued activity organized from last seven years, students were given detailed demonstration, idea and its stepping up well-in-advanced. Students were charged to communicate the nearby peoples in the society and communicate them to know about the theme. Community participants were given brief idea and objectives behind the activity.

Without having formal Inaugural, interactive based awareness of current problems of Electricity, its saving and some facts which must be known to everyone in the Society have been proposed. As observed and reported by the students, the community peoples have actively interacted. Proper and easy ways of handling Electric House-wares were also suggested to the community. It helped in changing the approach of the Community towards the problems of Electricity and their duties regarding.

With the kind cooperation of the community peoples, specially designed and prepared questioner has been circulated through the students to the community peoples. People marked the activity as a meaningful step toward imparting good ideas and care

taking suggestions in daily life electricity. In the initial years, activity was conducted in collaboration with the Maharashtra State Electricity Distribution Company Limited (MSEDCL), Amravati. In COVID-19 situation and lockdown scenario also activity through online mode was conducted. Now the activity is collaborated with the NGO LASER, Amravati.

To make aware and to have ready information, suggestive literature has also been given and circulated among the community people. Expertise teachers from the Department have given counseling to the students to percolate the ideas to the community. Dr. Bajpeyee also has given speech to the students with some practical sessions.

Major issues covered through the demonstrative speeches & survey activity are,

- To avoid contact with energized electrical circuits.
- Not to make fun with electricity.
- Treat all electrical devices as if they are live (even though, handled in OFF modes).
- Disconnect the power source before trying repairing electrical equipments (Plug OFF)
- Use only tools and equipment with non-conducting handles when working on electrical devices.
- Never use metallic pencils or rulers, or wear rings or metal watchbands when working with electrical equipment.
- When it is necessary to handle equipment that is plugged in, be sure hands are dry and wear non-conductive quality gloves, protective clothes & shoes with insulation.
- If an individual comes in contact with electric instrument, do not touch the person or equipment at any cost.
- If sparking of electricity is noted then contact immediately technical person.
- Never handle electricity without non-conducting wearing.
- Do not store highly inflammable or combustible materials at home.
- Avoid water (wet situations) at all times when working with electricity.
- Never touch or try repairing any electrical equipment or circuits with wet hands.
- Never use a faulty or ageing appliance as this may have a broken plug or frayed cord.
- Be extra careful when using electrical appliances attached to power outlets near kitchen or bathroom sinks, tubs, swimming pools and other wet areas.
- Do not use local equipments
- Do not use put the equipments in direct sunlight to avoid fast aging.

- 1. इस्त्रीची निवड करताना, ऑटोमॅटिक इस्त्री खरेदी करावी, जेणेकरून विशिष्ट तापमानाला इस्त्री बंद होईल.
- 2. फ्रिजमधून वस्तू काढताना आवश्यक वस्तू एकदाच काढाव्यात, जेणेकरून फ्रिज सतत उघडावा लागणार नाही. सतत फ्रिज उघडल्याने फ्रिजचं तापमान बिघडतं आणि जास्त वीज खर्च होते. डीफ्रॉस्ट करावे लागणारे रेफ्रिजरेटर्स आणि फ्रिजर्स नियमितपणे डिफ्रॉस्ट करावेत, बर्फ जमा झाल्यामुळे मोटर चालू ठेवण्यासाठी फ्रीजला जास्त ऊर्जा लागते. रेफ्रिजरेटर आणि भिंत यांच्यामधे पुरेशी जागा ठेवावी, जेणेकरून रेफ्रिजरेटरच्या भोवती हवा सहजपणे खेळती राहिल. रेफ्रिजरेटरमध्ये ठेवलेले पदार्थ झाकून ठेवावेत. कारण झाकण न ठेवल्यामुळे अन्नातील बाष्प उड्डन जातं आणि कॉम्प्रेसरला अधिक कामं करावं लागतं.
- 3. कित्येक जण सायंकाळी दिवे लावतात आणि हे दिवे गरज नसतानासुद्धा रात्रभर चालू असतात. ज्या खोलीत कमी वावर असेल किंवा कोणीही नसेल त्या खोलीचे दिवे बंद करावेत. तसंच कित्येकदा एका खोलीत दोन दिवे, लॅम्प असतात, घराला आकर्षक बनवण्यासाठी या दिव्यांचा वापर केला जातो. असे अनावश्यक दिवे गरज नसल्यास बंद करावेत.
- 4. शहरातील काही भागात विद्युतपंपाने टाकीत पाणी चढवावं लागतं. ब-याचदा टाकी भरून वाहत असतानासुद्धा माणसं विद्युतपंप बंद करत नाही किंवा त्यांच्या लक्षातच राहत नाही. यामुळे पाण्याचा आणि विजेचा अपव्यय होतो. या समस्येसाठी बाजारात स्वयंचलित यंत्रणा मिळते. या यंत्रणेत पाण्याची टाकी भरली की विद्युतपंप बंद होतो. या यंत्रणेचा वापर केला तर हजारो युनीट वीज सहज वाचेल.
- 5. वॉशिंग मशीन, ओव्हन, रोटीमेकर यांसारख्या वस्तू वापरताना टायमरचा वापर करावा आणि टायमर वाजला की लगेच उपकरण बंद करावं.
- 6. एसी, टीव्ही रिमोटने बंद केले जातात, पण त्याचा मेन स्विच बंद करण्यासाठी टंगळ मंगळ केली जाते. असं न करता रिमोटने टीव्ही, एसी बंद केल्यानंतर लगेचच मेन स्विच बंद करावा.
- 7. एसीचं बीलही जास्त येतं तसंच वीजही जास्त खर्च होते. काही जण एकदा एसी बसवल्यानंतर तो खराब होईपर्यंत त्याच्याकडे दुर्लक्ष करतात. एसीकडे दुर्लक्ष न करता दर मिहन्याला एसीचा फिल्टर तपासून, स्वच्छ करून घ्यावा. यामुळे थंडावा वाढेल आणि उर्जेचा वापर कमी होईल. एसी चालू असताना दरवाज्या, खिडक्या व्यवस्थित बंद आहेत ना, याची खात्री करून घ्या. थंड हवा बाहेर जात असेल तर कुलिंग कमी होतं आणि जास्त ऊर्जा खर्च होते. एसीचा दिवसा वापर करताना तुमच्या खोलीमध्ये सूर्यप्रकाश येणार नाही याची काळजी घ्या. हो, पण तुम्हाला नैसर्गिक सूर्यप्रकाश हवा असेल तर खिडक्यांवर रिफ्लेक्टिव्ह फिल्मचा वापर करू शकता. अशा रिफ्लेक्टिव्ह फिल्मस प्रकाशाला अडथळा न आणता ४० ते ६० टक्के उष्णता कमी करतात. या उपयामुळे वीजही वाचेल आणि तुमची खोली प्रकाशित होईल. एसी सुरू असताना पंखेही चालू असतील तर हवा घरभर खेळती राहते. एसीची सवृहिंसिंग वेळोवेळी करा.
- 8. एसीची देखभाल आणि वीज बचतीनंतर आणखी एक महत्त्वाची गोष्ट म्हणजे हल्ली सगळेच जण सीएफएल दिवे किंवा ट्युब्स वापरतात. कारण त्याने विजेची बचत होते. हे खरं आहे की सीएफएलमुळे वीज बचत होते पण, ही उपकरणं सुरुवातीच्या काही सेकंदात अधिक वीज खेचतात. सीएफएल ट्यूब सुरू केल्यानंतर जेवढी ऊर्जा खेचते, त्या उर्जेत ती नंतर दोन तास ऊर्जा देते. म्हणून सीएफएल दिवे, ट्युब लावल्यानंतर किमान तीन तास तरी तो बंद करू नये. जितक्या वेळा हे दिवे चालू बंद केले जातील तितक्या वेळ अधिक ऊर्जा खर्च होते आणि त्याचं आयुष्यही कमी होतं. त्यामुळे आधुनिक सीएफएल दिवे चालू केल्यावर जास्त वेळ ठेवा तसंच गरज नसल्यास चालू करू नका.
- 9. ज्या उपकरणांमध्ये कॉइलचा वापर केला जातो ती सगळीच उपकरणं अधिक वीज खातात. त्यात सर्वाधिक वीज खाणारा म्हणजे पंखा. कित्येकांच्या घरी पंखा दिवस-रात्र चालू असतो. त्या पंख्याला जराही विश्रांती मिळत नाही. त्यामुळे पंखा जास्तीत जास्त उर्जा खेचून घेतो आणि त्याची हवा कमी लागते.

- 10. ब-याचदा देव्हा-याचा झीरो बल्ब सतत सुरू असतो. झीरो बल्ब असला तरी हा बल्ब सुमारे १५ वॉटचा असतो. या झीरो बल्बपेक्षा सीएफएलचा तीन वॉल्टचा बल्ब लावावा. त्याचा उजेडही जास्त येतो. त्यामुळे वीज ही फारशी खर्च होत नाही.
- 11. हल्ली सगळ्यांकडेच मोबाइल आहेत. अनेक जण मोबाइल चार्जिगला लावून आपली कामं करतात. काम संपल्यानंतर किंवा मोबाइलची गरज भासल्यावर मोबाइल घ्यायला येतात, तोपर्यंत मोबाइल चार्ज होत असतो. ब-याचदा मोबाइल चार्ज झालेला असतो. फक्त दुर्लक्ष केल्यामुळे वीज उगाचच जळत असते. या पद्धतीमुळे वीज तर जळतेच तसंच मोबाइलही गरम होतो. अनेक जण मोबाइल चार्जिगला ठेवल्यानंतर फोन आला की, बोलण्याच्या नादात चार्जिगचं बटण बंद करायला विसरतात आणि फोन ठेवेपर्यंत चार्जिग चालूच असतं आणि वीज खर्च होते. यातील काही मंडळी तर फोन आला की बटण बंद करायला तर विसरतातच आणि फोनवर बोलून झाल्यानंतर तो फोन पुन्हा चार्जिंगला ठेवत नाही आणि आपल्या कामाला लागतात. यामुळे चार्जर तर गरम होतोच तसंच वीज जळते.
- 12. आंघोळीसाठी पाणी गरम करताना गिझरचाच प्रामुख्याने वापर केला जातो. काही जणांना अगदी कडकडीत पाणी लागतं म्हणून आंघोळ होईपर्यंत गिझर चालू ठेवतात. यामुळे वीज खर्च होते. या गोष्टीला आळा बसण्यासाठी बादलीत एकदाच पाणी घ्यावं आणि गिझर लगेचच बंद करावा.
- 13. सीएफएल अथवा एलईडी दिवे वापरावेत.
- 14. उतरताना शक्यतो लिफ्ट वापरु नये.
- 15. लिफ्ट मधील फॅन व दिवे बाहेर पडताना बंद करावेत.
- 16. जास्त स्टार रेटिन्गची उपकरणे घ्यावीत. (फ्रीज, वॉ मशीन वर असे रेटिन्ग असते).
- 17. ऑफीसात/घरी काँप्युटर मॉनिटर काम नसताना किंवा आपण जागेवर नसताना बंद करावा.
- 18. ऑफीसात वॉशरुम मधले लाईट्स गरज असेल तेंव्हाच लावावेत. बहुतेक सगळ्या ऑफीसेस मधे ते सदा सर्वदा चाल्च असतात.
- 19. पाण्याची मोटार वेळेत बंद करण्यासाठी तेव्हड्या वेळेचा गजर लावावा.
- 20. सणवारांना / शुभकार्याला घरभर केली जाणारी रोषणाई रात्री झोपताना बंद करावी.
- 21. मोशन/ऑक्युपेंसी सेंसर लाईट्सचा वापर
- 22. आपल्या मोबाईलमध्ये आणि लॅपटॉपवर एक पॉवर सेव्हर मोड (कदाचित ह्याला तुमच्या मोबाईल्/लॅपटॉपमध्ये काही वेगळे नाव असू शकते) असतो. तो ऑन ठेवल्यास मोबाईल/ लॅपटॉप आपोआप डिसप्ले सेटींग कमीत कमी वीज वापरली जाईल अशी अॅडजस्ट करतो. (काही स्मार्टफोन्समध्ये ह्यात बाहेर असलेल्या प्रकाशाचा अंदाज घेऊन डिसप्लेचा ब्राईटनेससुद्धा कमी/जास्त अॅडजस्ट केला जातो.) (लॅपटॉपमध्ये डिसप्ले ऑफ ची वेळ जरा अलीकडे येते.. म्हणजे तुम्ही २ मिनिटे जर लॅपटॉपवर काहीच केले नाही तर आपोआप डिसप्ले बंद होतो आणी पर्यायाने वीज वाचते.)
- 23. जे वायरलेस माऊस/कीबोर्ड वापरतात त्यांनी वापर नसतांना माऊस/कीबोर्ड बंद करायला हरकत नाही.
- 24. इलेक्ट्रीक गिझर वापरतांना जर शेवटचा अर्धा मिनिट गिझर बंद केला तरी गरम पाणी येत राहाते. हे नियमित केल्यास काही प्रमाणात तरी वीज वाचू शकते.
- 25. मायक्रोवेव मध्ये अन्न बनवणारे/ गरम करणारे असतील त्या कुटुंबातील सदस्य शक्यतो एकत्र (एकाच वेळेला) जेवायला बसल्यास अन्न पुन्हा पुन्हा गरम करणे टाळले जाऊन वीजेची बचत होते. 




